Comstock Park High School Responsibilities

- Establish clear and consistent expectations for students, staff, and parents to ensure a focus on learning.

Parent Responsibilities

- Ensure that your student arrives on time and attends school regularly.
- Encourage your student to become and independent learner.
- Engage in the school program by attending school functions and parent teacher conferences when possible.
- Demonstrate respect for the school rules and procedures.
- Treat all students, parents, staff and guests with dignity and respect.
- Work to develop a supportive educational partnership with teachers and school staff.
- Promote open communication with your student and all school staff members.
- Monitor your student's progress frequently to ensure that your student is progressing appropriately through the school program (Powerschool).

Student Responsibilities

- Establish organizational strategies that allow you to balance all of your responsibilities as a student (clean lockers, use electronic devices to help organize, establish a consistent time and space for school work completion, manage your time effectively, etc . . .).
