

Michigan Merit Exam:

11th graders must sit for the following exams in order to be considered for graduation:

SAT - Online College Entrance Exam with sections on Reading, Writing, and Math.

ACT WorkKeys - Career Readiness Exam (paper/pencil) with sections in Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, & Workplace Documents. Students need a 3 or higher in each section MSTEP - 2 online exams that assesses proficiency in Science & Social Studies.
