

This program is designed as the first step in preparing for kindergarten. Your child will benefit from early exposure to basic math, reading, vocabulary, fine and gross motor activities, classroom structure and social interaction.

Teaching number recognition, identification, and counting give our students a solid foundation for future math concepts. They will also be introduced to basic reading skills through vocabulary words, letter recognition, early book handling skills and nursery rhymes. Additionally, through the use of crafts and other activities your child will enhance their fine and gross motor skills. This will build strong hand muscles for writing and other tasks that will be used throughout their entire educational career. Finally, they will be given opportunities to further develop self-help skills and gain a sense of independence through classroom structure and social interaction.

Our goal is for your child to have a positive first experience to a structured school environment, through play and your child's natural curiosity.

The 3 Year Old class meets Monday, Tuesday and Thursday morning, from 8:40-11:40. Children must be toilet independent to attend.
