Education Benefit Forms or School Meals and Summer EBT Applications:

A new Education Benefit Form or School Meals Application must be completed annually to receive school meal assistance. The new forms will not be available until July 1, 2024. We are currently unsure if the Governor's State School Aid Budget for Free Michigan Meals will extend into the 2024-25 school year. Once the information is available, I will send out communication to all families, along with which form families will need to complete.

Food Allergies & Disabilities:

If your child has a food allergy or disability, please contact Melissa Alley to receive a medical statement that must be filled out by the child's doctor including what the allergy/disability is and what the substitutions can be. This form needs to be filled out anytime your child's allergies change to ensure we are providing proper/safe meals. Once the doctor has completed the Special Diet Statement, please email it to the Food Service Director Melissa Alley at malley@cppschools.com. Once the document is received the Food Service Director will contact the parent/guardian listed on the form to discuss meal accommodations and menu before it is put in place. Please make sure you send your child to school with meals until an alternate menu is made and the parent/guardian has spoken with the Food Service Director. Payment and Meal Accounts:

For your convenience, we accept payment online with debit or credit card. To do so you must log into your PowerSchool Parent Account to access School Pay. School Pay allows you to add money onto your student's lunch account. You may also send cash or checks with your child to school. Charging Policy:

All Comstock Park students are allowed to charge meals, should they forget their lunch money, up to a -\$10.00. Once student's negative balance exceeds this amount, the student will be placed on an alternate meal including a toasted cheese sandwich with a fruit and a milk until the negative balance is paid in full. The district will send home emails, letters, and make every effort to contact families. A-La-Carte items will not be allowed to be charged once an account reaches a negative balance.
